



As the pandemic stabilizes, the Dutch government is assessing the situation and has decided to ease previously imposed restrictions.

Less stringent rules:

It will only be necessary to wear a mask when traveling by plane, as well as inside the airport.

If you have been in contact with a positive, but do not have symptoms, you will be able to leave home in case of:

- Have a job to go to.
- Have received the booster vaccine in the last week, or have been vaccinated for 8 weeks.

If you have symptoms, stay home and get an antigen test.

Sport and public:

Outdoor games are again allowed, both indoors and outdoors. The public is also welcome again.

Restaurants and theaters open:

The reopening of restaurants, concert halls and theaters is authorized. This also applies to cinemas, museums, zoos and amusement parks.

Events:

Events such as concerts and fairs are allowed again.

New COVID testing policy Netherlands:

If you travel from a country of the European Union to the Netherlands, it will not be necessary to present a vaccination certificate, antigen or PCR test, or any other type of documentation related to Covid.

It is recommended to carry out a self-test when you arrive at your destination, in order to avoid the spread in case of contagion.
